Each classroom has three teachers and is supported by an instructional coach as well as our health and family engagement teams.

### Job Responsibilities

The Perinatal Engagement Coordinator reports to the Prenatal Manager. The Perinatal Engagement Coordinator will:

- Engage in mutually respectful, positive, goal-oriented partnerships with families to promote positive birth, child, and family outcomes
- Collect and document information with families and reflect with them to inform goal setting, planning, and implementation to effect progress and outcomes for families, children, programs, and communities
- Partner with families to build strong parent-child relationships and supports parents as the first and lifelong educators of their children
- Support families' planning and reflecting on safety, health, education well-being and life goals.
- Work with families to strengthen their support networks and connections with other parents and community members who can address families' strengths, interests, and challenges
- Work alongside parents to build on their strengths as advocates for their families and as leaders in the program and community
- Work with other professionals and agencies to support coordinated, integrated, and comprehensive services for pregnant mothers and their families across the organization, community, and system
- Ensure that enrolled pregnant woman have access to comprehensive services through referrals that includes: Nutritional counseling, food assistance, oral health care, mental health service. If applicable: substance abuse prevention and treatment and emergency shelter or transitional housing

### Qualifications

We seek candidates who are results-oriented and have the ability and willingness to work in a program located in a high-risk, low income community. You should have:

- Expertise in public health, social work, women's health, infant support, home visiting, or related field with, at minimum, an Associate Degree
- We prefer candidates who have: A Bachelor's degree in a related field. Experience working with families in a community-based Head Start or family support program preferred

The salary range is \$40,000-50,000, commensurate with experience.
