

## **Eligibility Document Checklist**

## **Educare DC – Moms 2 Be Prenatal Program**

Below is a list of required documents for eligibility determination. Note that an application cannot be processed until all documentation is received. To be eligible for Early Head Start/Head Start programming a family must be at or below the federal poverty level, receiving SNAP/TANF benefits, a foster child or ward of the state.

□ Valid Photo ID for Expectant Mom and Primary Contact/Support (if applicable)
